Did You Know?!

Dr. Shinichi Suzuki (1898-1998) was the creator of the Suzuki Method of Violin Teaching. One of his core beliefs was that students of all instruments could learn music the same way they would learn how to speak - thorough regular listening, repetition, and in a nurturing environment. Suzuki's method is still widely used today.

4. What is your favorite type of music?

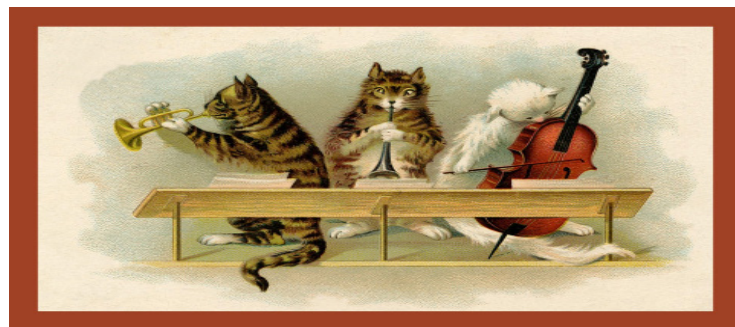
My favorite type of music, besides classical of course, is indie rock.
